

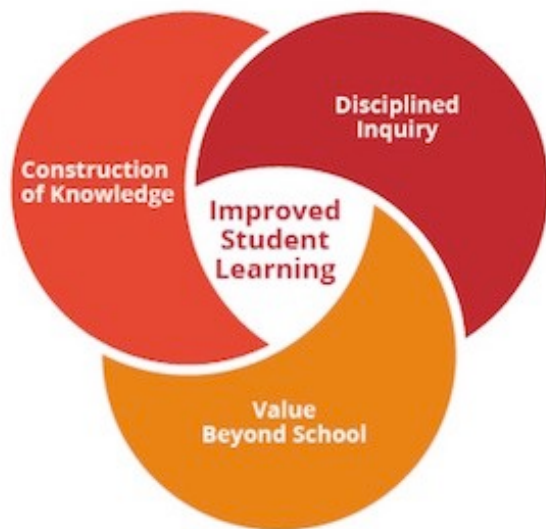
# Authentic Intellectual Work: Focus on Student Work
